Sheffield has a 69.4% employment gap between those with a learning disability and the overall employment rate

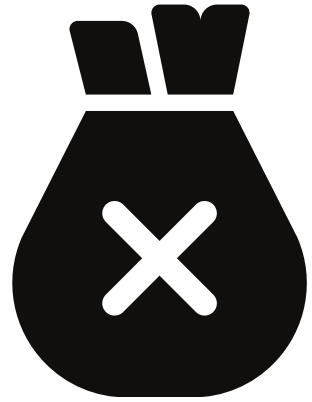

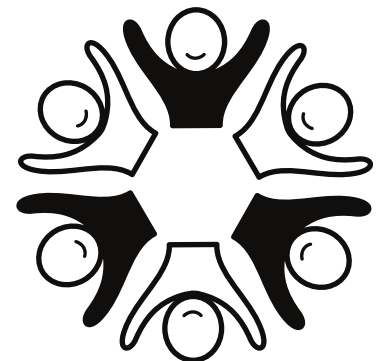

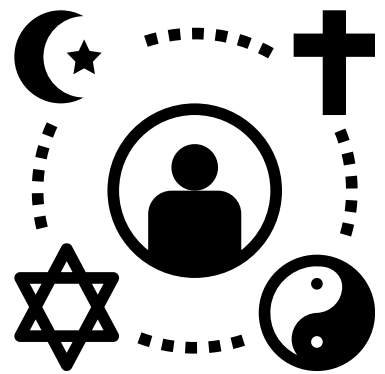

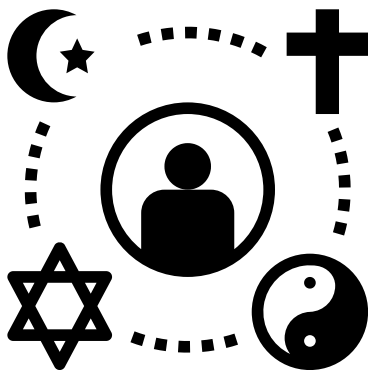

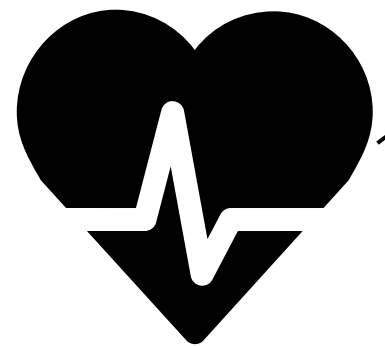

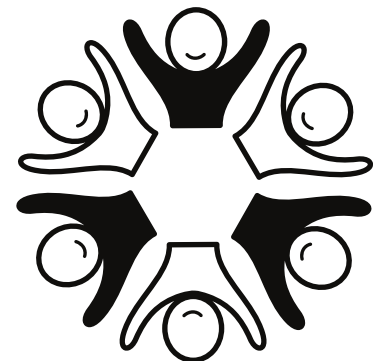
